## Math, ELA, Science, and Alternate Assessment Updates

- <u>We value your feedback</u>! First off, THANK YOU so much for your hard work and dedication in testing your students this spring. We understand it isn't an easy undertaking, but it is definitely a crucial piece of the educational process. Thank you again! We would love to hear your feedback! Please <u>complete this</u> <u>survey by May 17</u>.
- <u>Submitting a Medical Exemption</u>. Just a reminder, the Medical Exemption form is only available through today. Medical exemption requests must be submitted by the end of the day. A group of DOE administrators will make the final determinations on medical exemption requests in the next couple weeks.
- <u>ELA PT Results</u>. Some of your students have not received results for the ELA PT yet. If your student's tests are in completed/reported status, then they should receive a score. Results can take up to 10-15 business days after the testing window closed. The scoring centers are very busy, but the vendor is reallocating resources to complete the scoring. The vendor has increased readers and we hope to see movement from those shifts in the next few days.
- <u>Sending Results Home</u>. Once all your students' results are in the Reporting System, you can send the Individual Student Reports (ISRs) home to families. Please do this as soon as possible for math, ELA, science, and science-alt. Directions for printing ISRs are below. MSAA results will not be available until July or August.
