

SOUTH DAKOTA BOARD OF EDUCATION STANDARDS
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING-REGARDING ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS

A public hearing will be held at the Rapid City High School, Multi-purpose Room, 601 Columbus Street, Rapid City, South Dakota, on Monday, March 18, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. mountain Time, to consider the adoption and implementation of the following content standards. This is the fourth of four public hearings regarding these standards.

World Language: The proposed world language standards provide expectations for language learners to effectively communicate in more than one language with an appropriate understanding of cultures.

Library Standards: The proposed library standards provide expectations and age-appropriate guidance for successful student learning in textual literacy, informational literacy, and digital citizenship.
