The image above shows the “barracks” on the old Rushmore property which is used for storage and the facilities shop for the north and south campuses. The view below is of an old school annex with two classrooms, bathrooms, and an entry area. It is west of the building above and wired but not plumbed. Current use is cold storage.



The image below shows WDT's north and south campuses. The largest building in the top center (inside the red circle) is the main campus consisting of Mickelson buildings phase I & II. The Rushmore campus is enclosed in the red rectangle and consists of the Rushmore building, the day care center and two outbuildings for storage. Not shown to the north of the red circle is about 60 undeveloped acres on which this project will be constructed with ample room for future construction.
