EVENT DESCRIPTION

This two-day workshop provides an overview of Student Learning Targets and outlines a framework for developing SLTs to evaluate an educator's impact on student growth. Participants will also learn how SLTs fit into the context of South Dakota's recommended Teacher Effectiveness and Principal Effectiveness models.

FEATURED PRESENTERS

Three SLT trainers from Kentucky will lead participants through a best-practice approach to SLT construction, a process that is informed by lessons learned from their state's recent educator effectiveness pilot effort. The teacher-trainers will share a process-approach to establishing SLTs for all teachers, including grades and subject areas that pose challenges to assessment.

Who should attend this event?

This event is designed for teachers and principals, and was developed to support both the Teacher Effectiveness Pilot Project and the Principal Effectiveness Pilot Project, however districts and schools not participating in the pilot may attend.

Who is eligible to receive stipends for attending this event?

- **Teachers:** Teachers employed by schools participating in the 2013-14 Teacher Effectiveness Pilot are eligible to receive a \$125 per-day stipend (\$250 for both days). Up to three people per pilot and scale-up school are eligible to receive stipends.
- **Administrators:** Any principal or superintendent employed by a South Dakota public school is eligible for a \$125 per-day stipend (\$250 for both days).
