

No Child Left Behind

Distinguished Districts will be identified using the following criteria:

- a. Met AYP for two consecutive years in reading, math, and the other academic indicator for all three grade spans **AND**
- b. At least 85% of the students in the "all student" group have met the State's proficient and advanced levels of student performance in both reading and math.

To be eligible for the Distinguished District award, a district must have 25 or more students (10 or more students if 2009 or earlier) in each of the 3-5 and 6-8 grade spans and 25 or more students in the 11th grade.
